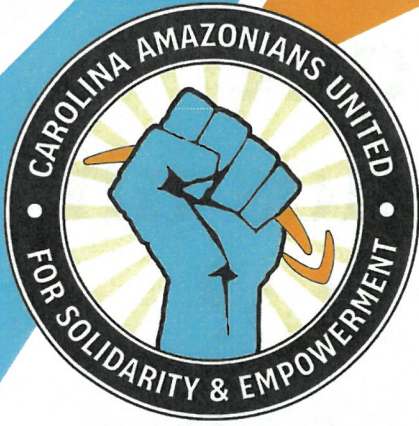




Why Do We Need A Union?
